 - a. Barekman: I believe it is important to guide these folks into getting the allocation they want. It would not be too far of a reach for the RSO to purchase boots and leather jackets in different sizes. If you are pairing a motorcycle with a person, not everyone can wear all of the leather jackets all the time.

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- b. Millington: If they go through with the bill, we are offered more leeway and can find more reasons to go through with funding.
 - c. McClellan: Because it is a bill, everything for the event has to be on it. Renting out the track is 8-10 grand to afford. The jackets also cost 800 a piece for purchasing. If we include it as protective equipment, it could be included. That would be part of the cost, they buy themselves. If they buy them outright, they can have them time and time again.
 - d. Barekman: On the ORS side, I do not believe there is a difference between the things that can be funded and need to be paid for on the allocation side vs the bill side. We must make sure it is something that can be funded by UCF.
 - e. Millington: We can see if they can make an agreement with the track rental to pay a one-time fee instead of having to pay a recurring fee.
 - f. Barekman: I would like to learn toward the purchase of equipment. Possibly buying some equipment but also renting some for the time being.
