  - a. Meeting with Michael Nunes
    - i. Camp: The purpose of the meeting was to find out how the pride commons came to be. There was an agency (not an RSO) tied to SG that advocated fro Pride Commons. Pride Commons gets funding through AS&F. PC filled in an empty space tied to the Union. We need to find out if there's any empty spaces on campus that can be used for a Disability Commons. That's step 1. Step 2 is finding another organization to occupy that space that isn't just students. The issue there is that funding for AS&F is getting cut.
    - ii. Ach: We have reserve money for projects. It's only used when there's a lot of interest in it
    - iii. Bar: I can talk to veteran services for this
    - iv. Camp: Any intersectional services on regards to this project is needed
    - v. Ach: I think we should focus on getting more interest in it, and future disability caususes need to focus on this.
    - vi. Camp: we need to keep summaries of meetings to make them accessible
