 - EC requested an interpretation of Title VI, Chapter 605, Sections 605.6-7, regarding which groups are permitted to make campaign donations and provide physical assistance.
 - In short, per Title VI, Chapter 605, Sections 605.5-7, donations/finances, campaign materials, or personnel from non-profit organizations are prohibited. As is any donation from a non-UCF student, staff, or faculty member representing such an organization. For-profit organizations that are not political organizations are permitted to donate or provide financial and personnel assistance to campaigns.
 - Compiling a reference sheet that covers SG's jurisdiction and scope to serve as a useful guide in case other Internal Bills or discussions arise pertaining to these issues.
 - Furthermore, this information is not an opinion and is not based on subjective interpretation. I'm compiling objective information through continued research on the subject and the information I've gathered from discussions with members of the administration.
