[Funding for Students for the Exploration and Development of Space to build a rocket for the Spaceport America Cup 2023 at Las Cruces, New Mexico on June 19th, 2023]

WHEREAS, Students for the Exploration and Development of Space (SEDS-UCF) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1980;

WHEREAS, The mission of SEDS-UCF is to promote the exploration and development of space. SEDS pursues this mission by educating people about the benefits of space, by supporting a network of interested students, by providing an opportunity for members to develop their leadership skills, and by inspiring people through our involvement in space-related projects. SEDS believes in a space-faring civilization and that focusing the enthusiasm of young people is the key to our future in space;

WHEREAS, SEDS-UCF members pay dues of \$21.00 annually;

WHEREAS, SEDS-UCF currently has 215 active members active, dues-paying members;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Composite Rocket Airframe is to design, build, and test a carbon fiber and fiber glass composite airframe;

WHEREAS, Students will be challenged with an exciting project and learn skills such as computer simulation, composite structure, CAD, manufacturing, and integration;

WHEREAS, The expected turnout for Composite Rocket Airframe is 18;

WHEREAS, SEDS-UCF has received a 5% funding sanction effective until July 17th, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Students for the Exploration and Development of Space has been allocated \$2,000.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year through CRT allocation 54-136.
