WHEREAS, American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1978;

WHEREAS. The mission of ASCE is to promote, stimulate, and maintain the spirit of engineering at the University of Central Florida, to secure for the University all the advantages and mutual helpfulness provided by a large national organization, and by the means of electing students to membership to serve as recognition for their efforts in actively participating as young adults in our American Society:

WHEREAS, ASCE members pay dues of \$30.00 annually;

WHEREAS, ASCE currently has 60 active, dues-paying members;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the American Institute of Steel Construction Steel Bridge Competition at Southeast American Society of Civil Engineers Student Symposium is to promote the challenge for students to extend their classroom knowledge to a practical and hands-on steel-design project that grows their interpersonal and professional skills, encourage innovation, and fosters impactful relationships between students and industry professionals in multiple fields;

WHEREAS, This event will teach members the technical skills required for the civil engineering industry outside of the classroom. To show national recognition that the University of Central Florida has a well-qualified civil engineering program;

WHEREAS, The expected turnout for American Institute of Steel Construction Steel Bridge Competition at Southeast American Society of Civil Engineers Student Symposium is 15:

WHEREAS, ASCE has received a 40 percent funding sanction effective until September 5th, 2023; and
