Fiscal Bill 54-30**

[Funding for 40 members of American Society of Civil Engineers to travel to the ASCE Southeast Student Symposium in Jacksonville, Florida from March 23rd, 2023 to March 26th, 2023]

WHEREAS, American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1978;
WHEREAS, The mission of ASCE is to promote, stimulate, and maintain the spirit of engineering at the University of Central Florida, to secure for the University all the advantages and mutual helpfulness provided by a large national organization, and by the means of electing students to membership to serve as recognition for their efforts in actively participating as young adults in our American Society;
WHEREAS, ASCE members pay dues of \$30.00 annually;
WHEREAS, ASCE currently has 60 active, dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of the ASCE Southeast Student Symposium is to gain real-world experience as civil engineers by participating in competitions related to the field of study against other schools in the southeastern region;
WHEREAS, All the prep leading up to conference and the conference itself are centered around the academia of civil engineering and how to apply classroom concepts to real-world projects;
WHEREAS, ASCE will be lodging at the Aloft Jacksonville Tapestry Park in Jacksonville, Florida;
WHEREAS, ASCE has received a forty percent funding sanction effective until date September 5th, 2023; and
WHEREAS, American Society of Civil Engineers received \$4,540.47 via Fiscal Bill 54-26 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Fourth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$2,325.00 be allocated to American Society of Civil Engineers from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all unspent funds revert to their originating account by April 24th, 2023;
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That American Society of Civil Engineers may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations, Review, and Sanctions Committee (ORS); and
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That American Society of Civil Engineers completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by May 1st, 2023, as a condition of receiving funding.
