
WHEREAS, The University of Central Florida Student Chapter of The American Chemical Society (ACS) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2014;
WHEREAS, The mission of ACS is to foster a cohesive community among students that promotes a positive image of chemistry and to bring chemistry awareness to the general public through appreciation and understanding;
WHEREAS, ACS members pay dues of \$15 semester;
WHEREAS, ACS currently has 26 active, dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of the ACS Spring 2023 - Crossroads of Chemistry is to share research, student chapter activities at the University of Central Florida, and to understand the importance of graduate school and research opportunities;
WHEREAS, ACS will attend workshops that include career fairs, professional development courses, chemical education courses, novel research in the chemistry field, and networking;
WHEREAS, ACS will be lodging at the Crowne Plaza Indianapolis - Downtown Union Station in Indianapolis, Indiana; and
WHEREAS, The University of Central Florida Student Chapter of The American Chemical Society received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Fourth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$6,776.97 be allocated to University of Central Florida Student Chapter of The American Chemical Society from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all unspent funds revert to their originating account by May 1st, 2023;
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That University of Central Florida Student Chapter of The American Chemical Society may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations, Review, and Sanctions Committee (ORS); and
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That University of Central Florida Student Chapter of The American Chemical Society completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by May 8th, 2023, as a condition of receiving funding.
