WHEREAS, National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE-UCF) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1998; **WHEREAS**, The mission of NSBE-UCF is to retain a talented and successful chapter dedicated to personal, professional, and academic growth;

WHEREAS, NSBE-UCF members pay dues of \$20.00 annually;

WHEREAS, NSBE-UCF currently has 89 active, dues-paying members;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the I AM S.T.E.M - #NSBE49 Annual Convention is to provide attendees with the opportunity to further personal and professional growth;
