**University of Central Florida
Fifty-Fourth Student Body Senate
Internal Bill 54-12**

[Updates to Title II]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;
WHEREAS, The term “Supermajority” is used 4 times in total throughout all Student Government governing documents;
WHEREAS, The definition of “Supermajority” was removed from statutes in 2019 through Internal Bill 51-40 and replaced with the term “Two-Thirds”;
WHEREAS, The definition of the term “Supermajority” prior to its removal from statutes was “At least two-thirds (twice as many “for” than “against”), as long as the number of “for” exceeds fifty percent (50%) of total currently filled seats”, which is nearly the same as the current definition of the term “Two-Thirds”;
WHEREAS, The term “Supermajority” was added back to Statutes in 2021 through Internal Bill 53-16, using the definition currently in statutes of “75% of total votes cast”;
WHEREAS, The term “Supermajority” should have been removed from Student Body Statutes after the passage of Internal Bill 51-40, removing the need for the term to be defined in Title II; and
WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Fourth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title II be amended as follows:

201.3 The following terms shall be defined in the Student Body Statutes as follows:

Supermajority ~~75% of total votes cast.~~

Two-Thirds- Twice as many for as against of votes cast.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all mention of “Supermajority” in Student Body Statutes and all other Student Government governing documents be replaced with the term “two-thirds” as defined by Student Body Statutes.
