University of Central Florida Fifty-Fourth Student Body Senate Internal Bill 54-23

[Updates to Title VI: Aligning Declaration of Candidacy Periods]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

WHEREAS, This Bill will align the Declaration of Candidacy period for all candidates;

WHEREAS, All candidates will also have the same election period;

WHEREAS, It is not necessary for presidential tickets to have 5 weeks to campaign and it is harmful for their academics to spend more than a month running for office;

WHEREAS, Declaration of Candidacy being scheduled at the same time for all candidates will simplify the job of the Election Commission; and

WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, **BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Fourth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title VI be amended as follows:

Chapter 603 Candidates

603.2 Senate Candidates

- A. A candidate may only declare candidacy for one (1) elected office during each election period.
- B. Candidates must submit a Candidate Application Packet
 - 1. Candidate Application Packets will become available online and in person in the SG office by 9:00 a.m. on the first (1st) school day of the first week of the Spring semester and will be due by 5:00 p.m. on the last school day of the stated Declaration of Candidacy period by 5:00 p.m. on the last school day of the fourth week of the Spring semester to the Supervisor of Elections and Student Government AdvisorSG Office Front Desk.
- C. Declaration of Candidacy for Spring elections shall be during the **fourth (4th)** second (2nd) academic week prior to the election and shall take place between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

603.3 Presidential Candidates

- A. A Presidential ticket must file a Petition form with the signatures of one hundred (100) students currently enrolled at the University of Central Florida.
 - 1. To be considered valid, a signature shall consist of: The typed name and the last eight (8) digits of the student's UCF ISO number.
 - 2. It shall be the duty of the Election Commission to verify that all submitted UCF ISO numbers correspond appropriately with the listed name on the candidate's petition.
 - 3. If, upon verification by the Election Commission, a candidate's Petition form is found to contain less than the required number of signatures, the candidate shall have until 5:00 p.m. on the first school

day following the end of Declaration of Candidacy to complete the Petition form. Any Petition form not fully completed by 5:00 p.m. on the first school day following the end of Declaration of Candidacy shall be considered invalid.

- B. Petitions may be obtained from the Student Government Senate Graduate Assistant no earlier than 9:00 a.m. on the first (1st) school day of the Spring semester. The Petition will be turned in at the time of the candidate's declaration of candidacy.
- C. Declaration of Candidacy for Spring elections shall be during the **fourth (4th)** fifth (5th) academic week prior to the election and shall take place between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

 - A. Campaign Limitations of up to 1 day
 - B. Electronic Media Limitations of up to 1 day
- 606.6 Tier II sanctions could be, but are not limited to:
 - A. Campaign Limitations of up to 3 days
 - B. Electronic Media Limitations of up to 3 days
- 606.7 Tier III sanctions could be, but are not limited to:
 - A. Campaign Limitations of up to 75 days
 - B. Electronic Media Limitations of up to 75 days
- 606.8 Tier IV sanctions could be, but are not limited to:
 - A. Campaign Limitations of up to 1410 days
 - B. Electronic Media Limitations of up to 1410 days
