[Senate Seats Reapportionment for Spring 2023 SG Senate Elections]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

WHEREAS, Student Body statutes mandate the reapportionment of Senate seats every year;

WHEREAS, Student Body statutes mandate the procedure for reapportionment;

WHEREAS, Section 302.2 of Title III: The Legislative Branch states when calculating the number of total seats, this value shall be based on the enrollment projections released by the Institutional Knowledge Management (IKM), prior to the start of each election period;

WHEREAS, One (1) Senate seat per every one thousand (1,000) students of each college, rounded to the nearest Senate seat, predicted to enroll the following semester;

WHEREAS, The statistics and information required to reapportion the Senate seats have been gathered from the Institutional Knowledge Management and can be referenced at https://ikm.ucf.edu/facts/interactive-facts/enrollment;

WHEREAS, The following apportionment is based on the enrollment of students in Fall of 2022;

WHEREAS, The total number of students at the University of Central Florida (UCF) in Fall 2022 was found to be 68,840; and **WHEREAS**, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, **BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Fourth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that the Student Government Senate be reapportioned for the Spring 2023 SG Senate Elections according to the following breakdown:
