## University of Central Florida Fifty Sixth Student Body Senate Internal Bill 56-45

[Updates to Title VI: Visual Obstruction]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

**WHEREAS**, Fair and transparent elections are essential to upholding the integrity of the Student Government at the University of Central Florida;

**WHEREAS**, Current election statutes prohibit the removal, vandalism, destruction, or theft of campaign materials but do not explicitly address visual obstruction, which can similarly interfere with a candidate's ability to campaign;

**WHEREAS**, Visual obstruction of campaign materials, whether intentional or negligent, can mislead voters, unfairly disadvantage candidates, and diminish the democratic process;

**WHEREAS**, Adding visual obstruction to the list of Tier IV election violations ensures that all candidates have an equal opportunity to communicate their platforms to the Student Body;

WHEREAS, This addition strengthens the enforcement of election rules and discourages unethical campaign tactics that could otherwise go unaddressed; and

WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect at the start of the 57th Senate Session.

*THEREFORE*, *BE IT ENACTED*, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title VI be amended as follows:

Chapter 606 Violations

606.4 Tier IV violations shall be:

K. Condoning or authorizing the removal, vandalism, destruction, visual obstruction, or theft of campaign material of another candidate.
