**University of Central Florida
Fifty Sixth Student Body Senate
Internal Bill 56-59**

[Updates to Title V]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;
WHEREAS, The Judicial Council is not vested the authority to remove any member of the Judicial Council from Office;
WHEREAS, Requiring Justices to possess a working understanding of essential governing texts enhances their ability to perform their duties effectively and in alignment with established procedures; and
WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title V be amended as follows:

Chapter 505 Powers and Duties of the Judicial Council

505.9 Judicial Quorum

- A. A quorum for an official meeting of the Judicial Council shall consist of a minimum of four (4) Justices and the Chief Justice.
- B. A quorum for ~~Student Government~~ **Judicial Council** hearings shall be set at fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the current membership **of the Judicial Council**.
- C. The Judicial Rules of Procedures shall provide guidance on the ~~removal~~ **resignation** of an Associate Justice from office for absences.

505.10 All Justices are required to have a working understanding of the following texts in order to fulfill their position in the Judicial Council:

- A. **Student Government Constitution and Statutes**
- B. **Judicial Rules of Procedure (JRP)**
- C. **Robert's Rules of Order**
 1. **All Justices must complete annual training on these texts. The Chief or Interim Chief Justice, guided by the Student Government Advisor, will administer the training.**
