- ix. Faucette: Florida Center for Students with Unique Abilities (FCSUA), housed here at UCF but is the umbrella for various programs across the state, held their annual conference. I am interning with them this summer so I worked the event and was able to attend their bi-annual Advisory Committee Meeting with representatives from across the state. It was mentioned in their presentation that they are interested in making our program at UCF (IES Inclusive Educations Services) more visible on UCF's campus (How can we promote campuses across the state to create their own programs if our own campus is unaware of our office and the program at UCF?). I mentioned to them that this is actually an initiative for us to do this year, so I will likely keep in touch after my internship is over to see how we can partner (along with Disability Caucus) to make that happen.
- x. Widerberg: Charging stations on campus and fixing outlets in the library
- xi. Gaudio: A&SF
 - 1. This fee and budget have gotten really thin. Can we raise this? It's easy for people to ask to raise the fee, but we should think about it from a political standpoint. Can we build up a unified movement with students and faculty to propose the idea of raising it and create some sort of detailed proposal. The SG President must be the one to initiate it under Florida law. Raising the fee is essentially really taboo, and it would be pretty impactful to band together to raise it.

b. Tabling schedule
