 - i) <u>57-018 Beta Alpha Psi Honorary Accounting Organization</u>
 - (1) Speech
 - (a) President and treasurer of org. Requesting for from Wednesday aug 14. I'm trying to get accounting students to be more involved in the community. Over the last few years, they have found that they have been able to attend due to funding. One of the officers was selected for a case study competition to tackle issues dealing with non-profit organizations. They presented their objectives in the format of a video for platinum status, for the standards they must adhere to. Posted in chat.
 - (2) Questioning
 - (a) Wangen: Did you submit the Loding quote with the request?
 - There is a conference rate that is stated on the website link and calculated based on the rooms that they need. They didn't include the advisor in the report submitted
