 - a. Rose: We had seen this near the end of last session. Originally, we voted for no sanction, pending that the total came out to \$10,614. Since we ended up not accepting some of the documents, the final total is a bit lower, placing them at ~86% contribution.

This was for our India trip. The issue was that the prices had dropped significantly and I couldn't really do anything about it.  - a. Rose: Generally, we decide sanctions starting from the statute recommended amount and reducing based on the circumstances. The recommended sanction itself can be reduced a bit if you reimburse the business office. If you paid back the business office to reach 50% contribution, it would go to 30% plus an additional 15% for reverting >20% of senate funds, for a total of a 45% recommended sanction. This would mean reimbursing the business office for \$2332.32. If you paid back the business office to reach 95% contribution, it would go to 30% for reverting >50% of senate funds. This would mean reimbursing the business office \$6301.25.
