 - a. One of the largest AIAA student chapters in nation. 3 bills, for rocket design, hovercraft, and quads. Exploring world of aeronautics. Rocket design is designing, simulating, manufacturing, and assembling a high-powered rocket. Last year had more teams than budgeted for, taken into account this year, 20 teams of 4-5 people in fall. Start meeting in September on a weekly basis. Very similar budget to last year, just adding more items to build extra rockets.

 - i. Funding from student dues of \$30 annually. Usually have around 400 members, sponsors, and this project has FSGC grant of about \$2500. Sponsorship from Northrop Grumman at about 2k.
