Discussion

- i. Varela: Minor changes to the survey with GAP's feedback. Changes: Now known as "Policy Areas," Scale is 1-10, Added link to DATC information.
- ii. Lipner: Can you provide more background and logistics into the new groupings of information?
- iii. Varela: I do want 5 policy areas to account for different student interests. Discussed having a university policy section with a member discussing that info. 6 different policy areas.
- iv. Is the goal to have one person per policy area?
- v. Approx. 4 people per group and 3 bills per person. That is why I would like to consolidate it to 5 policy areas.
- vi. Faucette: Can campus safety be combined with student well-being?
- vii. Varela: Yes, that's what I was thinking.
- viii. Lipner: I would also be in favor of mixing those. Curious about what administrative priorities you've heard that we've been supporting that would fall into these areas.
- ix. Varela: From conversations with GCA, help advocate for the budget. Helps UCF students have new buildings. Administration's ideas for students advocating for why the need this money. Very early idea but the appropriations task to group leaders because it's more difficult.
- x. Varela: Final vote to mix policy areas: Student well-being and campus safety.
- xi. Lipner: Cannot speak to whether we should have more policy areas. I need the survey to justify that happening. A lot of students cared about sustainability and wanted that to be heard, yet because it was the least supported, a decision had to be made.
- xii. Varela: This specific survey offers more nuanced views b/c of 1-10 scale. Use our best judgment to determine which is popular and not popular. In support of a lot of policy areas.
- xiii. Faucette: Do people know what we will be advocating for. Is there a disclaimer that we may not be able to cover all of these?
