- ii. "All Justice shall dispose of all matters fairly, promptly, and efficiently"

2. Krystal:

a. Rule 2.02 #2

1. Take out because we no longer have this training.

2. It states, "Attend Diversity Training (once per year)."

b. Rule 2.02 #5 [A]

- i. It states, "Title IX Training is not included in this requirement"

- ii. Title IX Training is something that we are doing now and rule 2.02.5 says that it is not a requirement, this is not presently accurate.

c. Rule 2.02 #13

- i. It states, "Attend a Student Conduct hearing once per month, after Student Conduct training has been completed."

- ii. Justices do not attend one per month, the rule should be more reflective of what justices can actually do. Justice participation is dependent on case load.

d. Rule 2.02 #12 clause

- i. "Attend a regularly scheduled Senate meeting once per semester."

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- e. As a committee we like that this requirement makes the relationship better between the branches.
 - i. We should include "It should not supersede work, or ..."
 - ii. In order to protect students from being wrongly panelized for not prioritizing school over being a justice.

 - g. We should reword the sentence that says that any assistant chief justice would be removed exclusively from their position and not from the council in order to make it clearer.
