    - (a) Speech
      - First, we want to say thank you for your time. We are the (i) society of Hispanic Professional Engineers, and we are requesting funds to go to our national conference. The conference is on October 29th and it will end on November 1st. We will be at the Philadelphia Convention Center. We bring our members to put their foot into this industry of engineering. It is hard to get jobs for CS majors and Aerospace majors and this experience will allow them to have good networking opportunities. This last year, we had about 40 interviews offered at conferences, and we had 30 internships offered to our members. There are some members that go on their own as well. Our members will be developing in terms of leadership opportunities. We want to take 60 members. We are in region 7 and we will get 2 free tickets; we only have to pay for 58 tickets. Comes out to a total of \$20,010. We want to arrive at the hotel on Oct 27th. We wanted to get members to get their early to avoid stress. Hotel \$15,186.29. New Airfare: \$23,092.80. We have other

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quotes from other hotels which are \$21,029.73, \$16,650.90, and \$19,750. We did pick the cheapest option for hotels.

  - (i) Southwest has a deal where if you take a group of 30 people, they suggest that one would be sort of like a chaperon, so they call them a tour leader. SO 29 people paid the regular airfare quote and then one of those people being the tour director would be given a much cheaper rate. Since we are taking 60 people they applied twice.
- (b) Kaufman: You said you had 828 active dues paying members, is that correct?

- (c) Kaufman: You also stated on your knight connect form that you received or anticipate receiving \$5,000 in outside funding sources. [F]But is that also supposed to include dues and other sponsorships. Is this number greater than \$5,000?
