☞ Good evening, Senators, I hope you're all doing great. First, I want to give a warm welcome to Texas Tech. It's a pleasure to have you here, and I hope you've enjoyed the day so far. I wanted to start off by giving a brief overview of my role. The Student Government Comptroller is responsible for overseeing how the entire campus spends the \$19M Activity and Service Fee budget, which is funded by students and supports things like events, programs, and services across campus. This role works closely with all branches of Student Government, as well as Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) and campus departments, to review purchase requests, manage budgets, and make sure all spending is responsible, transparent, and directly benefits the student body. All of the OPS guidelines for both the Legislative and Executive Branches have been signed and uploaded into Teams. The Judicial Branch is in the process of signing their guidelines. Also, the entire Executive Branch is on track to complete their financial training by tomorrow.

☞ Good evening, Senators! First, I want to extend a warm welcome to our visitors from Texas Tech University. We're honored to have you all with us tonight. This week, I coordinated with Vice President Benitez and uploaded the official minutes for the Agency and Department Strategic Planning Board. The Webmasters gave me a tentative date of July 23rd at the latest. I'll also be meeting with Senate Pro Tempore Hameed next week to begin building out a framework to translate the Statutes to Spanish and coordinating a meeting with the Hispanic Serving Institution Office. This is a project I'm especially excited about, so we can expand accessibility for Spanish-speaking students. Additionally, Senate Bill 57-02 has now been fully updated in the Statutes and posted to the SG website. I'm continuing to refine my legal opinion regarding Title XII and Sunshine Law.

- Senate Sweethearts, how is everyone doing? I’m super happy to report that I had my first introductory meeting with Speaker Courts and External Legislative Assistant Reed, we made some great work organizing a holistic plan for what cross-branch collaboration should look like from a communications standpoint. Some of the things we talked about include how we can increase activity on our lesser-performing platforms, such as LinkedIn. If you don’t already follow us there, I encourage you to link us to your profile, add us to your experience section and stay tuned as I will start uploading open seats and posting some special spotlight posts for high-achieving SG agents. Senate President Courts will expand on this in a little bit. We also talked about how to increase activity on our Facebook, keeping in mind the target demographic for Facebook users and how we could cater messaging to them specifically. As for our top-performing medium, we have increased our reach on Instagram by 55.5%! This is great guys! Our reels are really helping broaden our scope; they are by far the best performers in regard to non-followers specifically. So out of all of our content, our stories are being seen the most by our followers, but our reels are being seen the most by our non-followers, by 72.6% to be exact. These metrics are an amazing starting point for the year, so we’ll definitely keep this in mind as we move forward and produce more content for our Instagram! I also want to mention that I know there is a system being put in place for messaging and that ELA Reed will be your primary Liaison, but if you have any fun ideas for our Instagram, let us know! I am not opposed to doing some fun things like I know we talked about doing a Back To School video... so if you have any ideas, please share them with us!
- Another thing I would like to talk about with you all this evening is in regard to our signage in the SG Office. To paint the picture for you, when you walk in and look at the desktop area, you’ll see three posters. One is about SG as a whole, the different branches, caucuses, committees, election commission etc. The other poster is a brief brand guide... the third one says what we do! To fill up this space, I wanted to try and see what it would look like if we treated that sign as a community collage. So if you’re looking to participate, grab a sticky note, write about something SG does or has done in the past that inspires you or that you’re proud of! And stick it to the board.
