[Funding for 46 members of UCF Society of Women Engineers to travel to the WE25 – Society of Women Engineers National Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana from October 22nd, 2025, to October 26th, 2025]

**WHEREAS**, UCF Society of Women Engineers (UCF SWE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1975;  
**WHEREAS**, The mission of UCF SWE is to enhance the professional skills and promote the value of women engineers, and encourage young women to consider an engineering education;  
**WHEREAS**, UCF SWE currently has 545 active members;  
**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the WE25 – Society of Women Engineers National Conference is to live without limits while engaging in networking, gaining career insight, exploring cutting-edge technologies, and connecting with industry leaders on innovation;  
**WHEREAS**, Participants can attend interactive workshops on leadership and engineering subjects, cultivating relationships and empowering women;  
**WHEREAS**, Attendees will engage in panel discussions on emerging trends and best practices that will infuse fresh perspectives into UCF’s academic community;  
**WHEREAS**, Tailored sessions for early-career professionals and aspiring leaders will foster growth and networking opportunities that may leave attendees with secure internships and full-time offers, enhancing UCF’s reputation and the career prospects of students;  
**WHEREAS**, UCF SWE will be lodging at the Sheraton New Orleans Hotel in New Orleans, Louisiana;  
**WHEREAS**, UCF SWE has received or anticipates receiving \$5,000.00 in outside funding sources; and  
**WHEREAS**, UCF Society of Women Engineers received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Seventh Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$18,222.01 be allocated to UCF Society of Women Engineers from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That all unspent funds revert to their originating account by November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025;  
**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That UCF Society of Women Engineers may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations Review and Sanction Committee (ORS); and  
**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That UCF Society of Women Engineers completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, as a condition of receiving funding.
