WHEREAS, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter has been a Registered Student Organization since 1998; WHEREAS, The mission of Human Factors Ergonomics – Student Chapter is to facilitate discussion of the discipline, assist students with professional development, disseminate information, and to increase awareness of human factors and ergonomics;

WHEREAS, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society members pay dues of \$10.00 annually;

WHEREAS, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society currently has 18 active, dues-paying members;
