- a. Justice Mental health during Title IX
 - Have to start adding on more things onto the JRP for the Title IX Training section
 - 1. Justice Collazo working with Safety and transportation coordinator
 - Have a require mental health checkup after each one, whether a Justice wants to attend therapy, to make sure that no one is left in silence
 - Maybe have a debrief session with Lisyibet without revealing names or details, seeing as we can't talk to them to any student government agents or reporters
 - b. Have another Justice, alongside Chief Justice for this role
 - ii. Justice Kennedi will check into training and reporting obligations
 - 1. Justice Collazo possibly mandatory reporter
 - 2. Potentially on the Title IX advising form for those with reporting obligations, we will put a star beside their name
 - 3. On the form, allow students to choose which Justice if they want someone specific with specific background
 - iii. Might be two types of cases: one where student is already reported, and one where student will talk with Justice and go through process and personalized
 - 1. OPS student workers paid hourly, usually handle students in some way, might be a reporter
 - a. Worst case scenario: See if Justices who are mandatory reporters can still work on Title IX cases
 - 2. Might need to talk to Jake about distributing cases evenly because it is related to record-keeping
 - a. Potentially changing system of letting more people take on impartial advising cases and prioritizing people who have not
