 - i. Mandatory Reporting Obligations being handled by Justice Kennedi
 - Might be two types of cases: one where student is already reported, and one where student will talk with Justice and go through process and personalized

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- 1. OPS student workers paid hourly, usually handle students in some way, might be a reporter
 - a. Worst case scenario: See if Justices who are mandatory reporters can still work on Title IX cases
- d. Impartial Advising Outreach Efforts outside of students
- e. Justices and Mental Health during Title IX
- a. Justice Kennedi to meet with Jake in order to talk about tracking for justices and making sure everyone has a chance to do everything
- 6. New Business
 - a. AG Moore Discussion (Moved)
 - b. What kind of trackers might we want to see for various appeals?
 - i. How have our current systems been working?
 - We have scheduling assistant through Teams so we want to see how much we can use it
 - 2. Started talking to Jake about tracking impartial advising data
 - 3. Justice Collazo idea to use spreadsheet with list of Justices and create a column of who shadowed what and who can lead the next one
 - 4. Jake would like to keep the tracker within leadership for privacy reasons
 - ii. What hasn't been working?
 - See if we can do a council discussion to address privacy concerns with sharing impartial advising/Title IX cases and whether it should be internal private record
 - 2. Kennedi will talk to Jake about this
 - iii. How do you imagin we can improve this while keeping what does work?
 - 1. Balancing privacy and transparency
 - 2. Instead of showing how many Justices have done one, and each Justice can see how many you've done out of all of the cases.
 - Maybe we can have point system for the cases, and see if it works as an internal record rather than exposing it to the entire branch --> keep it as a self-check
 - 4. Seeing if we can have an internal or external report to show how many students receive our services and do a post-survey with a Justice that they spoke with to see how we can improve

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- c. Title IX JRP Updates
 - Want to start compiling Title IX resources for the JRP and see what the process looks like during the process
 - ii. Aim for completion by the start of spring semester
 - iii. Should include a Title IX campaign every year to raise awareness and a campaign for impartial advising for SCAI --> possibly collaboration with JOC, may not necessarily be a requirement
 - iv. Make it clear in the JRP that not all Justices have to do Title IX Training, as well as a post meeting to see if Justices are okay
 - v. In the JRP, we currently do not have an impartial advising category
 - 1. Add what training looks like and what meetings look like for the section
 - Add what Justices have to do and what they don't have to do for every meeting, and we might have different sections for each type of case
 - 3. Emphasize that Title IX training is not a requirement --> possibly adding that we can do a survey to see which Justices are interested, and make sure there isn't any peer pressure to join.
 - 4. See if Justices have any preferences and are uncomfortable working with victims or perpetrators, etc.
 - 5. Making sure we don't compromise confidentiality and privacy as Justices seek mental health support resources, etc.
