 - a. Proclamations: 5-5-5

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- i. [Proclamation 57-09](#) [Proclamation Declaring the Month of October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month] [Chair Renda]
 1. Speech: Since 1985 October has served as Breast Cancer awareness month. Over 300,000 people are diagnosed, and 42,000 women lose their lives to it each year. This month honors the need for awareness and needs to reduce the stigma around it. The health center and the pharmacy have expressed an interest in tabling and spreading awareness.

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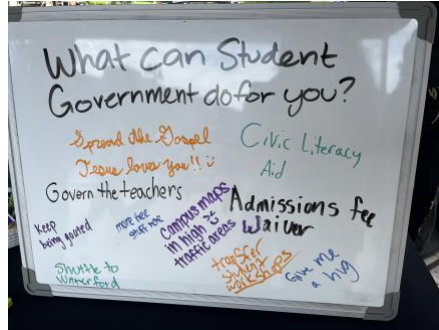
